Kanchenjunga Expedition Itinerary:

Day 01: Kathmandu

Arrival in Kathmandu 1350m/4428ft. Airport pickup by a representative of Himalayan Nepal Trek and transfer to hotel on BB plan

Day 02: Preparation

Preparation, Briefings at Departments of Tourism. Overnight at hotel on BB plan.

Day 03: Bhadrapur

Flight from Kathmandu to Bhadrapur 94m/308.399fit 40 minutes. Overnight at hotel on BB Plan.

Day 04: Ranipul

Drive by jeep from Bhadrapur to Helok Khola or Ranipul 1792m/5879.265fit 7/8 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 05: Sherpa Gaun

Trek from Ranipul to Sherpa Gaun 2995m/9826.115fit 6/7 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 06: Tortong

Trek from Sherpa Gaun to Tortong 2995m/9,826ft 8/9 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 07: Tseram

Trek from Tortong to Tseram 3870m/12,697ft 6/7 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 08: Ramche

Trek from Tseram to Ramche 4530m/14,862ft 5 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 09: Ramche

Rest and acclimatization day before reaching Tso Glassier camp back to Ramche 6/7 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 10: Glacier Camp

Trek from Ramche to Glacier Camp 5176m/16,981ft 6 hrs. Overnight at tented camp.

Day 11: Advance Base Camp

Trek from Tso glacier camp to Kanchenjunga Advance base camp 5400m/17,717ft 5/6 hrs. overnight at tented camp.

Day 12-50:

Kanchenjunga climbing period (8586m/28,169ft) Summit Base Camp to Base Camp.

Day 51: Base Camp

Preparation and clean the camp for return. Overnight at tented camp.

Day 52: Ramche

Trek from Base camp to Ramche 4530m/14,862ft 7/8 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 53: Tortang

Trek from Ramche to Tortang 2995m/9,826ft 6/7 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 54: Sherpa Gaun

Trek from Tortang to Sherpa Gaun 2080m/6,824ft 8/9 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 55: Ranipul

Trek from Sherpa Gaun to Helok Khola or Ranipul 1792m/5879.265fit 5/6 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 56: Ilam Tea Garden

Drive from Ranipul to Ilam Tea Garden 3636m/11,930ft 7 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

Day 57: Kathmandu

Drive from Ilam to Bhadrapur airport 4-hour flight to Kathmandu. Overnight at Hotel on BB plan.

Day 58: Kathmandu

Leisure day, evening farewell dinner in a typical Nepali cultural restaurant. Overnight at Hotel on BB plan.

Day 59: Departure

Departure from Kathmandu to your onward destination our representative will assist you to the airport for your further destination ahead.

Includes and Excludes

Includes

- 4 Times airport pick up and drops (domestic and international) Car, Van, Hi-ace, or Coaster in a standard private vehicle.
- 4 nights hotel in Kathmandu 5* Marriott Hotel single room on bed and breakfast plan.
- Welcome Dinner in a Nepali cultural dance restaurant with office Staff.
- 1 Night Hotel in Bhadrapur 3* Bed and Breakfast plan.
- Assistance for cargo clearance in Nepal's Customs Department, clearance cost is subject to a charge. Before the expedition.
- Expedition Royalty and permit of Nepal Government to climb Mt. Kanchenjunga.
- Kanchanjunga Conservation Area entry fee (KCAP).
- Kanchanjunga restricted area permit and all necessary paperwork fees.
- 1 Government Liaison officer with full equipment, salary, and accommodation.
- Stool Shipment Transfer & Garbage Deposit fees.
- Medical & Emergency rescue Insurance of all involved Nepalese staff during the trek and the expedition.

- Each member has one Himalayan Nepal Trek Duffel Bag.
- Domestic Flight: Fly from Kathmandu / Bhadrapur /Kathmandu and drive from Bhadrapur up to Helok Khola Rani Pul (by Jeep). As per the itinerary while returning Drive from Helok Khola Rani Pul up to Bhadrapur.

- Necessary all equipment Transportation for all Members and Staff from Kathmandu to Helok Khola Ranipul (by Truck and jeep) and from Helok Khola Ranipul to Base Camp (By Porters) While returning: Base Camp to Helok Khola Ranipul(by Porters) Kathmandu (by Truck or Bus).
- Up to 60 Kg per member for personal baggage during the trek carried by the porters.
- 3 meals a day Breakfast Lunch and Diner including tea and coffee along with accessible accommodation at Hotel/Lodge/Tea house/Camp during the trek and Base Camp, a wellmanaged base camp set up for members and Staff.
- All Necessary equipment for Camping during the trek.
- Porters per member up to Base camp from Helok Khola Ranipul while returning porters from Base camp to Helok Khola Ranipul.
- Experienced and well-trained Base Camp Cook and kitchen Helpers as required.
- All Nepalese staff and porter's daily wages, salary, equipment, food, and clothing.
- Each member will have an individual North Face tent in Base Camp.
- At Base camp: foam mattresses and pillow per member, 1 Dinning Tent, 1 Kitchen Tent, 1

 camp staff, Store tent, Tables and chairs, and all necessary cooking gears.
- Heater for base camp in each Dining.
- 1 Solar panel or Generator for battery charge and light at base camp.
- 1 veteran and Government Licensed Climbing Sherpa per member (1 Member: 1 Sherpa).
- Climbing Sherpa's Salary, Equipment, Food, and Clothing.
- Summit Oxygen: 3 oxygen bottles (4 liters) for each member and 2 oxygen bottles for each high-altitude Sherpa.
- 1 Set of Summit Oxygen masks and regulator for each member, and Sherpa.
- Back up Oxygen Cylinder, mask, and regulator (with appropriate charge).
- High Altitude Tent, Necessary cooking EPI gas, cooking pot, High food for a member, Sherpa, and other crews at (C1), (C2), (C3), and (C4) Group climbing gears and fixed and dynamic rope during the climbing period as required.
- The experienced Sherpa's (Personal Sherpa) team will fix the route on Kangchenjunga (no extra charge will be applied to full board members).
- A Satellite Phone for emergency communication carried by Sherpa is also available for members at the appropriate charge.
- Walkie—Talkie for communicating from Base Camp to Mountain and Mountain to Base Camp.
- Satellite Phone/walkie-talkie permit for all members and staff.
- Weather forecast report during the expedition.

- Comprehensive Medical kit for group and staff.
- Mt. Kanchenjunga climbing certificate issued by the Ministry of Culture Tourism and Civil Aviation after climbing Mt. Kanchenjunga successfully.

Excludes

- International flight airfare (from and to Kathmandu).
- Nepal Visa fee is USD 60 per person for 30 days (to be applied for 60 days is USD 120).
- Lunch & dinner during the stay in Kathmandu (also in case of early return from Trekking / Expedition than the scheduled itinerary).
- Extra nights' accommodation in Kathmandu in case of early arrival or late departure, early return from Trekking / Expedition (due to any reason) than the scheduled itinerary.
- Travel and high-altitude insurance, accident, Helicopter medical & emergency evacuation mandatory.
- Medical and emergency rescue evacuation costs if required. (Rescue, Repatriation, Helicopter, Medication, Medical Tests, and Hospitalization costs).
- Telephone Calls, Internet, Toiletries, battery recharge, hot shower, laundry, soft drinks, beers, and any Alcoholic beverages (during the trek and in Kathmandu but we will have soft drinks for members at base camp).
