Muktinath Darshan Yatra Itinerary 05 Days

Day 01: Kathmandu

Arrival in Kathmandu 1350m | 4428ft. Airport pickup by a representative from Himalayan Nepal Trek and transfer to hotel on BB plan.

Highlights:

- Airport Pickup by our staff with our (Place card) Company Logo and your name on it.
- Hotel check-in at Thamel (tourist city).
- Briefing related to the Muktinath Yatra.
- Staff's Introduction Guide and Assistance Guide.
- Shopping for the necessary items if needed.
- Welcome dinner program.
- · Overnight at a hotel.

Day 02: Pokhara

Drive from Kathmandu to Pokhara on a Tourist Bus - 200km, around 9 hours. Stay overnight in a hotel.

Highlights:

- Have breakfast and embark on an 8 to 9-hour journey to Pokhara.
- Drive via beautiful typical villages and small cities.
- View of the beautiful Trishuli River and Marshyangdi River along the road.
- View of the most beautiful Pokhara lakes surrounded by the Annapurna Mountain range.
- In the evening, explore the lakeside market and relax at your hotel in Pokhara.

Day 03: Jomsom

Highlights:

Drive from Pokhara to Jomsom - 155km, approximately 8 hours. Stay overnight in a lodge.

- Enjoy a picturesque drive to Jomsom (about 155km) by Jeep through Tatopani.
- Take a lunch break at Tatopani (hot spring), and if interested, soak in the hot bath by the Kali-Gandaki River (optional).
- Continue your drive to Jomsom, with striking views of hills and mountains.
- Evening free time to wander around the market area. Spend the night at a Jomsom hotel.

Day 04: Muktinath - Jomsom - Pokhara

Visit Muktinath and return to Jomsom, then back to Pokhara. Stay overnight in a hotel.

Highlights:

- Start your day early with a 1.5-hour drive to Muktinath, offering stunning mountain views.
- Take a 30-minute walk to reach Muktinath Temple.
- Explore the temple at your own pace.
- After the ceremony, drive back to Jomsom.
- · Check out and drive back to Pokhara.
- In the evening, enjoy free time or explore the lakeside market. Stay overnight in a hotel.

Day 05: Kathmandu - Departure

After Breakfast drive back to Kathmandu and depart.

• Departure from Kathmandu to your onward destination our representative will assist you to the airport for your further destination ahead.

Recommended Sightseeing in Kathmandu Valley

Pashupatinath Temple, Swayambhunath (Monkey Temple), Kathmandu Durbar Square, Bhaktapur Durbar Square, Patan Durbar Square, and Boudhanath Stupa.

Excludes

- Emergency rescue and travel Insurance (most required factor in high altitude trek).
- Trip cancellation cost, loss, damage, and personal effects.
- Entrance fees for temples, monasteries, and museums during sightseeing and Yatra.
- Tips and gratuities for the staff.
- Additional overnight stays cost at any place (due to any reason) except for the mentioned itinerary.
