Adjacent to the temple, there are two sacred ponds known as "Mukti Kunda," where Hindu devotees take a dip under the chilled water, believing that it brings them spiritual liberation. You'll have the opportunity to offer prayers, perform worship rituals, and seek blessings at Muktinath Temple.

After your spiritual sojourn, you'll return to Ranipauwa, where the helicopter awaits. You'll then board the helicopter for a scenic flight back to Kathmandu. Upon arrival, you'll be transferred to your hotel, where you can relax and engage in leisure activities. You'll spend the night at the hotel.
