

Pikey Peak Dudhukunda Trek

Standard Itinerary

Day 01: Arrival

Arrival at Kathmandu TIA 1310m.

welcome by Himalayan Nepal Trek staff then Transfer to Hotel Fuji Thamel (Tourist city)
Introduction with guide and assistance guides. Overnight at Hotel Fuji.

Day 02: Sightseeing

Sightseeing in Kathmandu valley (UNESCO world heritage site). Overnight at Hotel Fuji.

HIGHLIGHTS:

- Pashupatinath: Hindu Temple.
- Swayambhunath: Monkey Temple.
- Boudhanath: Largest Mandala Temple in Nepal.
- Patan Durbar Square: Ancient Palace rich in art, culture, and structural design.

Day 03: Dhap

Drive to Dhap 2820m 8/9 hours. Overnight at Tent.

HIGHLIGHTS:

- View of Everest range.
- Beautiful isolated Nepali villages.
- Landscape in gigantic hills.

Day 04: Jhapre

Trek to Jhapre 2920m 6/7 hours. Overnight at Tent.

HIGHLIGHTS:

- Experience a beautiful botanical environment.

- Wild orchids.
- Rich rhododendron forest.
- Plain hills.
- Pine forest.

Day 05: Pikey Base Camp

Trek to Pikey Base Camp 3640m. 6 hours. Overnight at Tent.

- Preparation Day
- Dance program with (Tungna Baje) plucked string instruments from the Northern Himalayan region.
- We prepare to climb the Pikey Peak the following day.

Day 06: Junbessi

Trek to Pikey Peak 4100m and trek down to Junbessi 2700m 7/8 hours. Overnight at Lodge.

HIGHLIGHTS:

- We climbed all the way up to Pikey Peak.
- Revealing landscape with a breathtaking range of Mountains like Mt. Everest (8848m), Number Chuli 6959m, Thamserku 6608m, Kangtega 6685m, Khatang 6853m, Kanchenjunga 8586m, Manaslu 8163m, Dhaulagiri 8167m, Gaurishankar 7134m, Dorje Lakpa 6966m and Langtang.
- Everest 8848m, the highest mountain in the world.
- Dhaulagiri 8167m, the Seventh highest mountain in the world.
- Hanged Prayer flags on the summit of Pikey Peak.
- Beautiful Hill sidewalk.
- Spread-out hills and valleys.
- Junbessi is one of the most beautiful villages of Nepal, typical sherpa village of Nepal.
- Beautiful Monastery.
- Stay at the beautiful Apple Garden lodge.

Day 07: Yak Kharka

Trek to Thupten Choling monasteries and Trek to Yak Kharka 3840m. Overnight at camp.

HIGHLIGHTS:

- Beautiful Tibetan monastery.
- Visit Mini-Tibet Village.
- Day 08: Trek to Sasurabeni 437m 4 hours. Overnight at Tent.
- HIGHLIGHTS:
- Strong Climb.
- Yak herd.
- Change in Vegetation.

Day 09: Dudhkunda Lake

Trek to Dudhkunda lake 4593m 4 hours. Overnight at Tent.

HIGHLIGHTS:

- Close view of two Holy Mountains above 6900m.
- Glacier approach.
- Glacier Lake.
- Approach to the base of the mountain Mt. Numbur 6958m.

Day 10: Chhore

Trek to Chhore 3925m 5 hours. Overnight at Tent.

HIGHLIGHTS:

- Golden Leaves shrubs.
- Juniper trees.
- Buddhist cultural influence.

Day 11: Takshindu Monastery

Trek to Takshindu Monastery 2800m 6 hours. Overnight at Tent.

HIGHLIGHTS:

- Beautiful Landscape.
- Hillside walking.
- Pine forest.
- Traditional local wooden bridge.
- Big Buddhist Monastery.

- Traditional Village.

Day 12: Phaplu

Trek to Phaplu 2413m 6 hours overnight at Tent.

HIGHLIGHTS:

- Traditional Farming.
- Buddhist stupas along the path.
- Apple Garden.
- Local Airport.
- A small city in Lower Everest.

Day 13: Kathmandu

Fly to Kathmandu and transfer to Hotel Fuji Thamel. 25 minutes flight Overnight at the Hotel.

HIGHLIGHTS:

- Mountain Flight to Kathmandu.
- Aerial view of the Hills of Nepal.
- Aerial view of Isolated Villages of Nepal.
- Aerial view of the Rivers of Nepal.

Day 14: Departure

Departure from Kathmandu to your onward destination.

Includes and Excludes

Includes

- 3 Times airport pick up and drops (domestic and international) Car, Van, Hi-ace, or Coaster in a standard private vehicle.
- 3 Times food per day during the trek. Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner including tea or coffee
- 3 Night 3* star label hotel in Kathmandu on BB plan (on twin sharing basis).
- Drive from Kathmandu to Dhap by Public Jeep all staff and guest

- Staffs transportation Phaplu to Kathmandu
- Flight fare Phaplu/Kathmandu guest and guide.
- Twin-sharing accommodation during the trek (guest house/Tea house, tented camp, and lodge)
- Experienced English-speaking local guide (Trained and licensed holder by the government of Nepal)
- Necessary staffs Cook, Kitchen and Porters, porter carries 25kg per porter
- All Government and Local Taxes.
- First aid and equipment for a porter for the extreme adventure route.
- All staff's salary as per the company policy and government rules.
- Facilities to store your stuff at a hotel in Kathmandu.
- Duffel bag during the trek.
- Company t-shirt.
- Route map.
- Staffs medical insurance during the trek.

Excludes

- Lunch and Dinner in Kathmandu.
 - Participants trek equipment and any personal expenses such as alcoholic beverages, phone, battery charging, hot shower, hot/mineral water, and laundry.
 - Emergency rescue and travel Insurance (most required factor in high altitude trek).
 - Trip cancellation cost, loss, damage, and personal effects.
 - Entrance fees for temples, monasteries, and museums during sightseeing and trekking.
 - Tips and gratuities for the staff.
 - Additional overnight stays cost at any place (due to any reason) except for mentioned itinerary.
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
